WHO MAY USE THE LIBRARY

- 1. Library materials may be checked out by persons holding either a current Garner Public Library card or a card from a member Beacon library who are in good standing. Garner Library cards may be issued, or re-issued, to people in good standing upon presentation of suitable identification.
- 2. Non-residents will be required to show identification with current address. A Garner library card will be issued to them as an "Open Access" patron. Persons from Beacon library communities will be encouraged to get a card at their home library if possible.
- 3. Open Access Patrons are entitled to the same borrowing and reference services as local users, except for interlibrary loan service. They will be encouraged to contact their home libraries for this service.
- 4. Service will not be denied or abridged because of age, physical disability, sex, sexual preference, religious, racial, social, economic, or political status.
- 5. The use of the library or its services may be denied for due cause. Such causes may include, but are not limited to, failure to return materials, destruction of library property, disturbance of other patrons, or any other objectionable conduct on library premises.
