

## DVDS

1. DVDs may be checked out by all patrons in good standing. No DVD borrowing privileges or use of the Internet will be extended to patrons with outstanding fines.
2. Two titles per library card may be checked out at one time for three (3) days and may be returned in the book drop. DVDs not returned on time will incur a \$1.00 per day late charge and will accrue up to the cost of the DVD. Patrons with a DVD fine will be restricted from checking out more or using the Internet until the fine is paid.
3. DVDs should be used with adult supervision. Any DVD returned damaged which proves unusable will be charged to the patron at the cost of the material. The Garner Public Library shall not be held liable for any damage incurred to the patron's equipment caused by the library's DVDs.
4. DVDs are available on a first-come first-served basis. Persons desiring to use public-performance DVDs for programs may reserve a title for a specific date.
5. The patron is responsible for compliance with all applicable restrictions of the copyright laws. Most DVDs owned by the Garner Library do not have public performance rights and are for home use only.
6. As stated in our Circulation Policy, usage of library materials by children and young adults is assumed to be a matter of parental responsibility.
