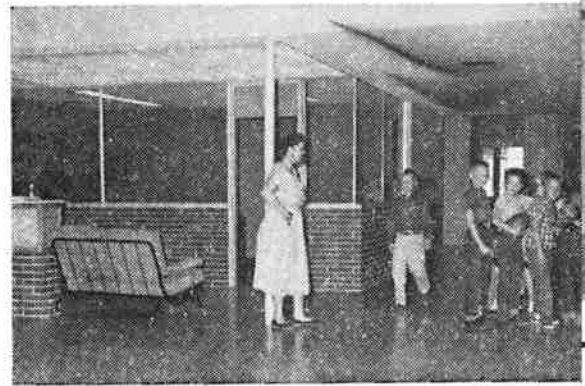


The floor plan shown above is correct except for the detail of designating grade levels. The building houses Kindergarten through Fourth, not through Sixth as designated.

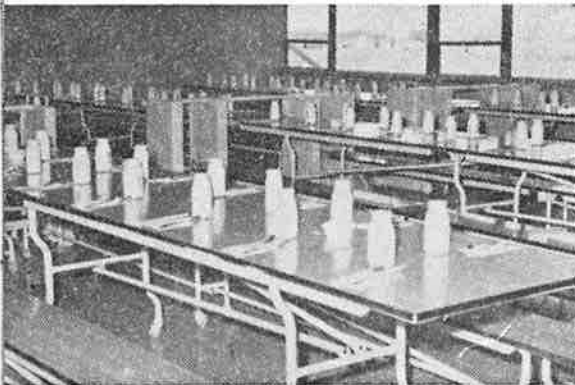


The office area and wide hallways are well-lighted and ventilated giving the building a pleasant atmosphere of working conditions.

The building is planned to make student control and movement, orderly and quiet. The materials used in construction were both attractive and economical. The children like their new school.

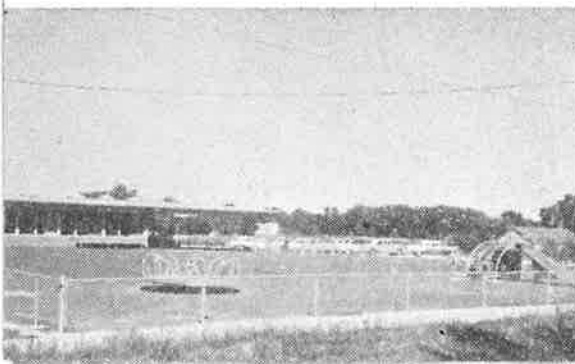
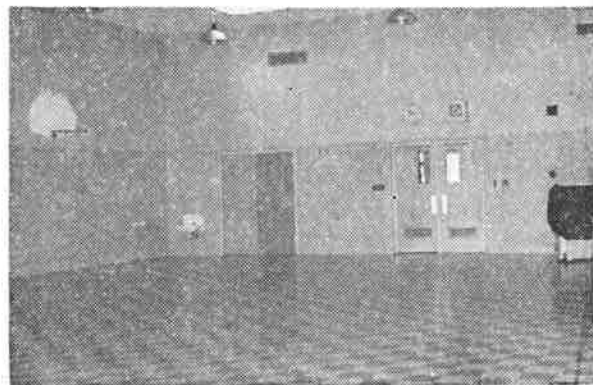

Recreation and exercise play an important part in the life of any child. At the right is pictured the Activity Room and below is a picture of the black-topped play area.

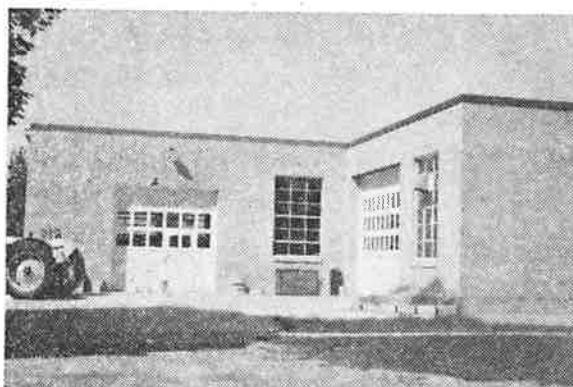


All the playground equipment for small children was purchased with safety as the first requirement. The area pictured at left is for the use of kindergarten and first grade students.

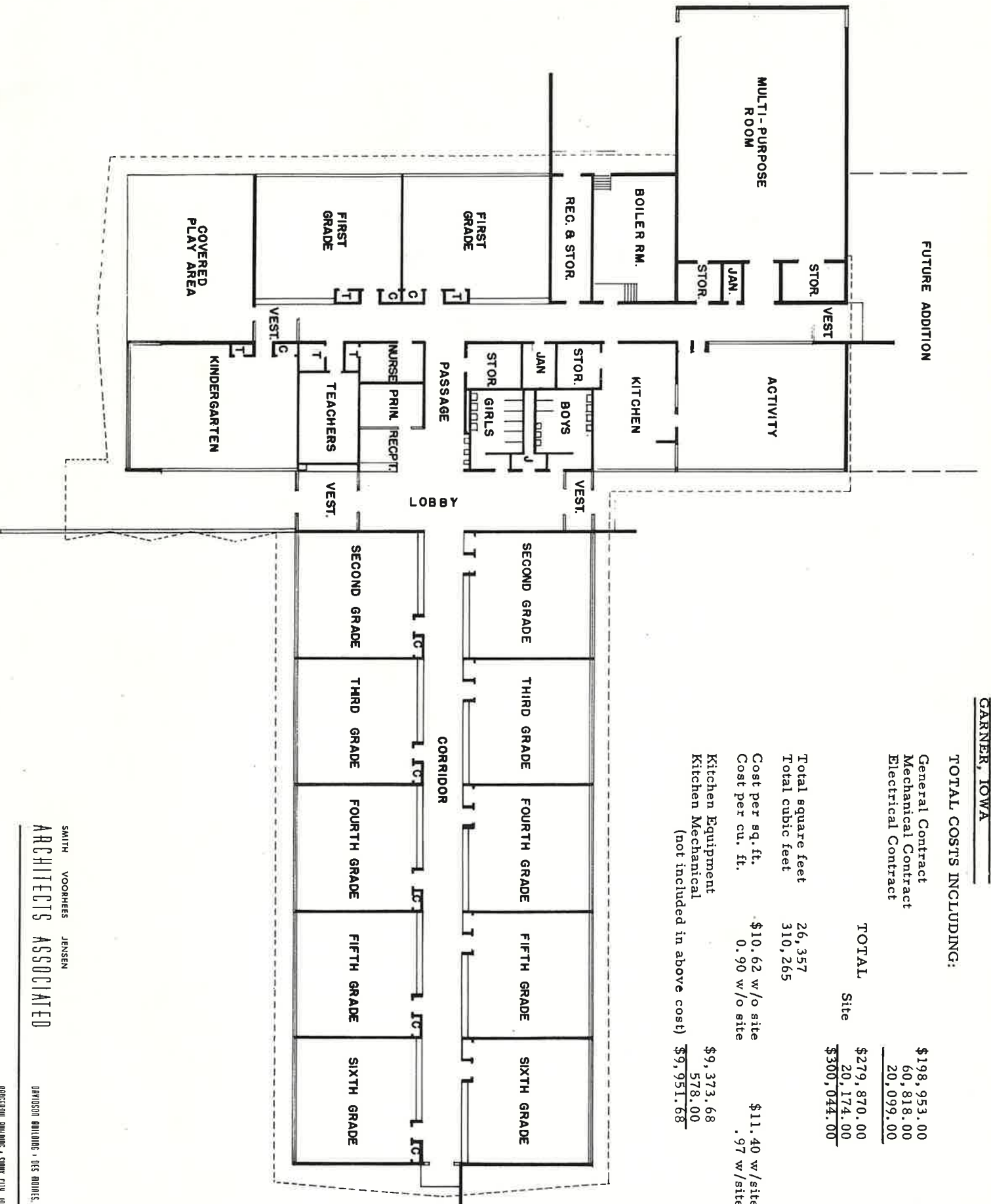
