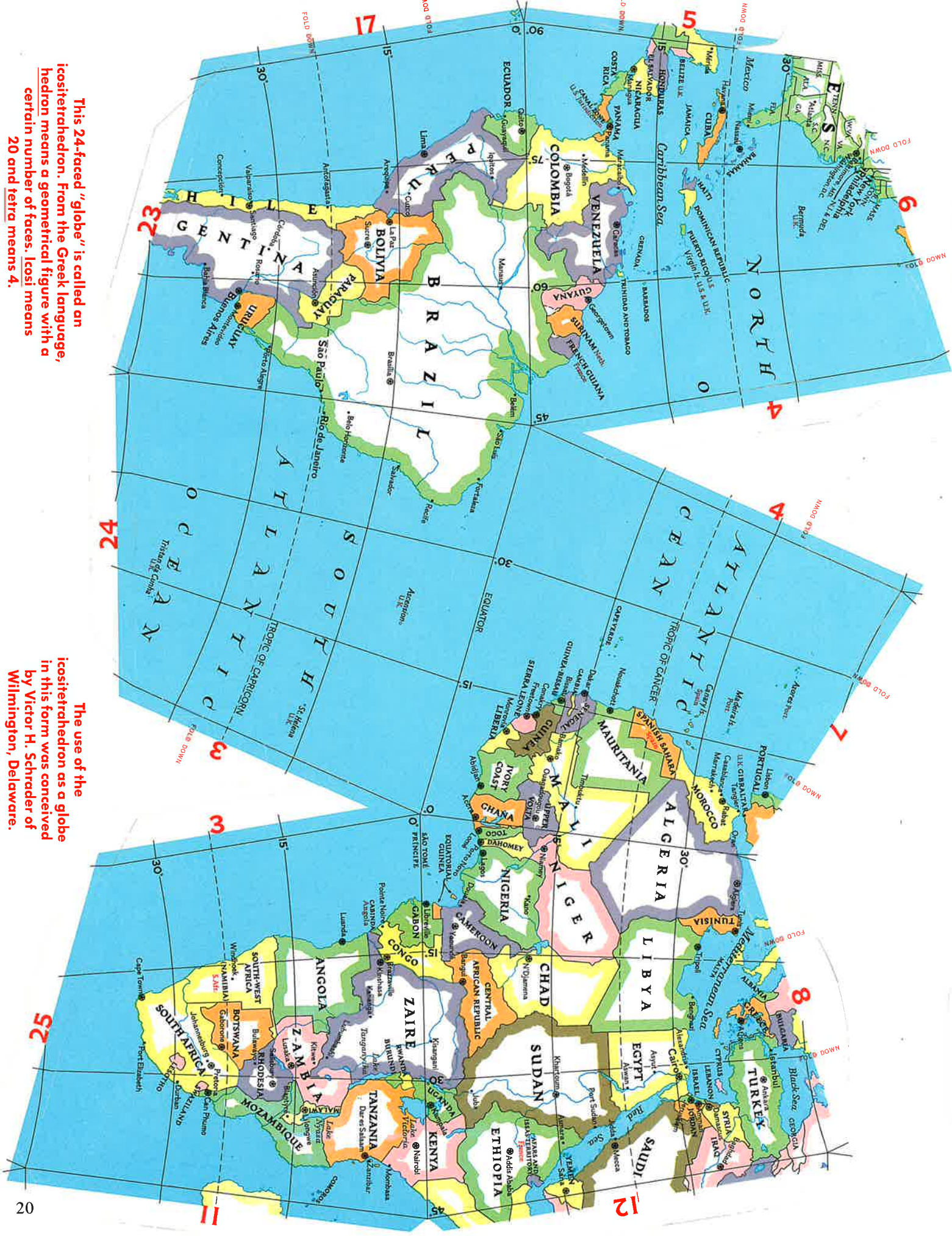


MAKE YOUR OWN GLOBE
A Political Globe (showing countries and cities) can be formed by matching the red-numbered tabs and slots. A Physical Globe (showing mountains and deserts) can be formed by matching the black-numbered tabs and slots.

The use of the icositetrhedron as a globe by Victor H. Schröder of Wilmington, Delaware.



This 24-faced "globe" is called an icositetrhedron. From the Greek language, hedron means a geometrical figure with a certain number of faces. Icosi means 20 and tetra means 4.

TO FORM THE POLITICAL GLOBE
Punch out the four sections and lay them with the red-numbered sides UP. Fold DOWN all the creased lines and tabs. Insert the red-numbered tabs in the matching red-numbered slots.
